Master Sergeant William D. Hanrahan Jr. is the Senior Maintenance Controller for the 109th Maintenance Operations Flight, Stratton Air National Guard Base in Scotia, New York.

MSgt Hanrahan entered the uniformed services 1996. He graduated technical school, was assigned to the 109th Aircraft Generation Squadron and was selected for full-time duty as an Active Guard Reservist under the United States Antarctic Program.

In 1999 as an LC-130 Flight Engineer with the 139th Airlift Squadron, he pursued a degree in Criminal Justice in conjunction with flying mission sorties as a Traditional Drill-Status Guardsman (DSG). He earned Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree from Schenectady Community College and a Bachelor's Degree from Empire State College

In 2003 he joined the 139th Airlift Squadron's Life Support Section He deployed to Iraq in 2008 as an AFE Craftsman with the Special Operations Command.
